You cannot build relationships without trust. And you cannot build trust with preschoolers if you look like a stranger. Remember that they look forward to seeing familiar faces each week.								

•	We understand that life happens, and sometimes you are
	unable to be here. If it is not an emergency, please let the
	Ministry Director know at least 24-36 hours prior.

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-	Interact with the children in meaningful ways, engaging
	them in discussions and listening—really listening—to what
	they have to say.

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- Always be on alert for potentially unsafe situations.
- Please do not carry children around or let them jump/ hang on you.
- Emotionally—be happy to see them. Give eye contact. Get on their level. The more you can be positive and specific, the more you will build an atmosphere of acceptance. And the safer they will feel with you.
- When a child is being hurt, hurting others, or hurting themselves, it is your responsibility to seek the help of an adult in an authority position immediately.
